Then children need to choose a number and work out how many more they need to make 10 or 20. Following on from this children need to attempt writing the sum both ways.</p> <p>E.g. $7 + 3 = 10$ $3 + 7 = 10$</p> <p>Ext: Can they work out the inverse?
